1. Per FCA policy, we do not use iPads in elementary due to the ever increasing problems with the upcoming generation of students lacking writing skills such as cursive and print. Thankfully, legislation is now being presented to make "writing" a requirement in school again.
2. We offer elementary computer classes for grades K4 – 5 with an emphasis on typing skills for grades 3 – 5.
3. We strictly enforce our NO FOOD, DRINK, or GUM policy within the classrooms.
4. Computer math lab is offered for middle and high school (FCA provides the computers).
5. We provide a state of the art Apple computer lab for middle and high school.
6. The Athletic Program offers elementary, middle and high school sports opportunities such as volleyball, basketball, softball, baseball, track & field, and we are moving towards football.

Requirements for Parents/Guardians:

1. Family Christian Academy expects both parents to be practicing Christians. If only one parent is a Christian, the following is required:
 - A. The unsaved parent *cannot be hostile* to the gospel. God has created the child so that the parent is the primary influence in shaping his outlook and personality. This influence must be pro-Christian. If it is anti-Christian, most of the influence of the Christian school will be counteracted by the home and a partnership with the school cannot result.
 - B. The non-Christian parent must be in agreement with the enrollment of the child and must sign all necessary forms.
 - C. The family should attend church regularly.
 - D. Family Bible reading and prayer should be a part of the normal home routine.
 - E. The primary motive for enrollment must be for *spiritual development in an academic setting*.
2. The family will agree to work in a partnership relationship with the school and back the school fully in the training of the child.
3. Tuition payments will be made in accordance with the enrollment contract.

Requirements for Student:

1. The student must be able to do the required academic work.
2. The student's attitude and life-style must be compatible to the Family Christian Academy Student body.
3. Students who do not want to attend a Christian School should not be enrolled.
5. The student will agree to study and comply with all the policies of the student handbook of Family Christian Academy.

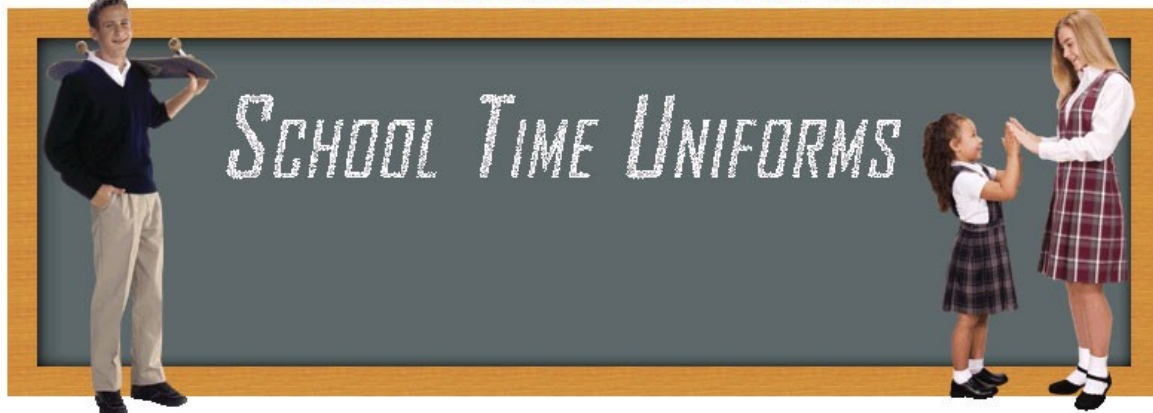

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
